CONGRESS SITES IN BARCELONA

All these traits have made Barcelona a first-class tourist destination, and the ideal place for meetings and congresses. This open, welcoming city shed its skin and opened to the sea to host the 1992 Olympic Games. It completed its seafront with the new Forum zone, which opened in 2004, and is the site of some of Europe’s largest hotel and congress facilities. 1.- AUDITORIO ZAL

Avda. Ports d'Europa, 100 – Puerto de Barcelona

ZAL is the intermodal logistics platform of the Port of Barcelona. Its aim is to attract maritime traffic with services of logistics infrastructure with added value to the goods. A real logistics center and economic engine of the city. ZAL has been the first port logistics platform established in Spain; its development is a model and the term ZAL has become a generic term.

The **Service Center** provides a wide range of equipped areas to rent with the latest technology and appropriate services for the development of any business spaces: underground and outdoor parking, shopping gallery, restaurants, fitness center, leisure areas and green area. There you will find de Auditorium in which the next Congress will take place. It is also complemented by a separate terrace with sea views

The Congress will take place during April, Thursday 16th, full day, and Friday 17th noon.

2.- GRAN HOTEL REY DON JAIME****

Avenida del Hotel, 22 – 08860 Castelldefels (Barcelona)

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Castelldefels is a city with a large history in which lithic ruins of 80,000 years of age have been found, as well as upper Paleolithic ruins, Bronze Age, Iberian, roman, medieval, etc... that have left its print in the city, with numerous remains of cultural interest and full of charming places.

On top of the hill at 59 meters above sea level, overlooking the southern part of the Llobregat delta and over what used to be an Iberian village and a roman villa afterwards, stands the castle of Castelldefels. In 2001 the mayor of Castelldefels approved a programme to use the castle and carried out restoration and refurbishment works.



Placed over a hill in the Natural Park of Garraf and in front of the impressive Coast of Barcelona, the Gran Hotel Rey Don Jaime is located in a unique, nice and quiet environment close to the city. Inside the Hotel, next to the swimming pool and the wide gardens, a historic fortified tower which was used as a maritime surveillance place in the XVI century, is preserved.

3.- RESTAURANTE LA BARCA DEL SALAMANCA

Moll de Gregal, 13-17 – Puerto Olímpico de Barcelona

This Restaurant, with a large tradition, has its origins in the suburb of Barceloneta, singular for its fishing history, where its owner placed his first Restaurant in 1971, offering the real sea cuisine. In 1.992, year in which Barcelona hosted the Olympic Games, the current Olympic port was created, place where Barcelona is even closer to the Mediterranean and moment in which La Barca de Salamanca is born, where you can taste great dishes close to sport ships and boats.

4.- LA MASÍA CAN TRAVI NOU

C/ Jorge Manrique, s/n – Barcelona

Can Travi Nou is a real Catalan Masía of the XVII century, owned by the family Soler Ribatallada, which was refurbished to host the business. Well known by its charming places and a gastronomic referral in the city, with more than 30 years of experience, Can Travi Nou offers to the market cuisine lovers, a rustic and cozy place to enjoy a magnificent cuisine, in touch with nature.



Gala dinner will take place here on Friday, 17th of April.

5.- LA SAGRADA FAMILIA

C/ Marina - Barcelona

The expiatory church of La Sagrada Família is a work on a grand scale which was begun on 19 March 1882 from a project by the diocesan architect Francisco de Paula del Villar (1828-1901). At the end of 1883 Gaudí was commissioned to carry on the works, a task which he did not abandon until his death in 1926. Since then different architects have continued the work after his original idea.

The building is in the center of Barcelona, and over the years it has become one of the most universal signs of identity of





the city and the country. It is visited by millions of people every year and many more study its architectural and religious content.

It has always been an expiatory church, which means that since the outset, 133 years ago now, it has been built from donations. The building is still going on and could be finished some time in the first third of the 21st century. When the church is finished it will have 18 towers: 12 dedicated to the apostles, 4 to the evangelists, one to Jesus and another to Mary.

The visit to La Sagrada Familia will be made on Thursday, 16th of April, at 06:30 pm.

6.- TRANSFERS

For the correct Development of the Congress there will be at your disposal a bus service to make your transfers from the Gran Hotel Rey Don Jaime to the different activities easier, as well as to the Auditorium ZAL and the visits for escorts and delegates from IKD who had chosen the cultural visit on Thursday 16th, to the joint visit to Sagrada Familia and Gala dinner afterwards.
